

Delegate Regulations

Chapter Delegates

1. A delegate represents a parish chapter at the Clergy-Laity Philoptochos Assembly. A Philoptochos member in good standing is chosen or elected by the chapter to represent their membership. 'Good standing' is elections have been ratified and per capita to the Metropolis and National for 2008-2009 is current. The delegate is entitled to be heard and to vote in accordance with prescribed rules governing the assembly and is required to attend all general sessions of the assembly and assigned workshops.
2. A chapter in good standing is entitled to have three (3) delegates total at the Metropolis Clergy-Laity. The parish chapter President shall be a chapter delegate. If the parish chapter President is not able to attend, the next ranking officer shall serve as a delegate. There may be an additional two (2) delegates elected from the general membership of members in good standing.

Alternate Delegates

1. An alternate delegate's name is submitted in the registration packet along with the name of the delegates representing the parish.
2. Upon notification that a delegate cannot attend, the alternate will receive full credentials from the Registration Committee designating her a full delegate.
3. No registration fee is submitted for an alternate delegate.
